Dear Prime Minister,

We express our support for the amendments to the laws of the Hungarian Parliament aimed at protecting children from indoctrination through LGBT ideology.

These amendments to a number of Hungarian laws (Child Protection Act, Act on Business Advertising Activity, Media Act, Family Protection Act and Public Education Act) introduce a prohibition of the "portrayal and the promotion of gender identity different from sex at birth, the change of sex and homosexuality" for persons under 18.

It represents a noble aim to protect children from the inherently harmful and immoral LGBT ideology, and therefore deserves to be commended. Christian moral teaching, human dignity and state sovereignty are core values of our European Union, and we cannot compromise on these principles.

Indoctrination of minors on the basis of LGBT ideology constitutes a clear breach of their fundamental right to dignity, as provided in the EU Charter and international law.

We fundamentally disagree with the decision of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Lithuania, led by G. Landsbergis, to "condemn" these amendments to Hungarian law that protect the rights of minors.

We stand to protect the rights of all citizens of the nations of the EU.
